In spite of trying times in our area and state, your devotion to CASA and the children we serve remained steady and true;

CASA of Terrebonne has always been a program embodied with foresight. We continuously educate and prepare ourselves to address the needs of abused and neglected children in a manner that directly benefits our community. Hence, as 2016 progressed and a trend of a steady influx of children entering foster care in Terrebonne Parish became obvious, our program began to identify ways that we could get the community's attention to this issue and inform how they could help. Thanks to our wonderful citizens stepping up to help CASA of Terrebonne in 2016, we:

• Swore-in 15 new volunteer advocates;

- 86 active volunteers advocated for 81 children, and traveled 32,357 miles;
- Enhanced CASA of Terrebonne's visibility in the community using digital billboards, newspaper and personalized radio advertisements, large banners hung throughout downtown Houma, and daily social media advertisements;
 - Increased child abuse awareness and CASA advocacy awareness;

• Two successful fundraisers: 17-Week Raffle and recipients of the 9th Annual Crawfish Boil-off, hosted by devoted community partners;
