As a result of the family dynamics, Annette advocated for a transfer of custody to a relative. Her CASA child could not be any happier in her placement. Hearing her CASA child say, "I love you Ms. Annette" is undeniably heartwarming.


For being chosen as advocate of the month, Annette will be receiving a polo shirt donated by Shelly Toups with Artistic Embroidery.
