I am pleased to report that in 2015 the Board of Directors, staff, volunteers, and supporters of CASA of Terrebonne remained loyal to our commitment to serving the abused and neglected children of Terrebonne Parish. The reality of children entering into the State's foster care system remains an ongoing plight. Thus, we remain diligent in pursuing volunteer

advocates who will accept the mission of standing as the voice for a child in the courts.

The following are a few of our achieved goals during 2015, for which we are proud:

- Increased volunteer recruitment, training, and retention;
 - Swore-in 38 new volunteer advocates;
 - 90 volunteers advocated for 137 children;
- Developed new and maintained outstanding community partnerships that directly benefited the children we serve;
 - Enhanced CASA of Terrebonne's visibility in the community;
 - Increased child abuse awareness and CASA advocacy awareness;
 - Two successful fundraisers: Playhouse Raffle and 8th Annual Crawfish Boil-off;

• Successfully implemented new web-based case management system for volunteers.


