Message from Executive Director, Donna M. Brunet

October is bullying prevention month so take the time out to talk to your children about bullying.

"When adults respond quickly and consistently to bullying behavior they send the message that it is not acceptable. Research shows this can stop bullying behavior over time."

"Parents, school staff, and other adults in the community can help kids prevent bullying by talking about it, building a safe school environment, and creating a community-wide bullying prevention strategy." <u>Stopbullying.gov</u>

Here are some national statistics about bullying:

The 2017 School Crime Supplement (National Center for Education Statistics and Bureau of Justice) indicates that nationwide, about 20% of students ages 12-18 experience bullying.

In surveys, approximately 30% of young people admit to bullying others.

70.6% of young people say they have seen bullying in their schools.

70.4% of school staff have seen bullying. 62% witnessed bullying two or more times in the last month and 41% witness bullying once a week or more.

When bystanders intervene, bullying stops within 10 seconds 57% of the time.

Even when they were a little hesitant with new settings, like the jail, they made themselves available to obtain first-hand information. At one point the children were in two separate homes, but that did not hinder their commitment to both children. They coordinated their schedules and made face-to-face visits and attended sibling and family visits to ensure the children were doing well. When the case took a turn, they were the first to contact our office with their concerns. Their sweet demeanor and compassion for people made them great candidates for a second case. When they were approached about two teenagers, they were nervous about it but they again dove in and seem to be enjoying their new connections. We at CASA are so blessed to have them as part of our CASA family.
